Attention of all concerned is invited to the publication of this Institute's Advertisement No. 2/2015 whereby seven posts of Technician (1) were advertised.

In pursuance of the CSIR directives issued recently, the selection methodology for the above seven posts shall be as follows:

“The candidates as recommended by the Screening Committee will be invited for a trade test. Those who qualify in the trade test will be invited for a competitive written examination. The final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidates in the Competitive written examination.”

Following shall be the **Mode of Examination** for the said seven posts:

Medium of Questions	The questions will be set both in English and Hindi except the questions on English language.
Standard of Exam	SSC + ITI/XIIth Standard
Total number of questions	150
Total Time Allotted	2 hours 30 minutes

Paper – I (Time Allotted – 1 Hour)

Subject	No. of questions	Maximum Marks	Negative Marks
Mental Ability Test*	50	100 (two marks for every correct answer)	There will be no negative marks in this paper.

*Mental Ability Test will be so devised so as to include General Intelligence, Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning, Problem Solving, Situational Judgement etc.

Paper – II (Time Allotted – 30 minutes)

Subject	No. of questions	Maximum Marks	Negative Marks
General Awareness	25	75 (three marks for every correct answer)	One negative mark for every wrong answer
English Language	25	75 (three marks for every correct answer)	One negative mark for every wrong answer

Paper – III (Time Allotted – 1 hour)

Subject	No. of questions	Maximum Marks	Negative Marks
Concerned Subject	50	150 (three marks for every correct answer)	One negative mark for every wrong answer

Accordingly, the list of short-listed candidates for the said posts will be displayed on the Institute's website shortly and the short-listed candidates will be invited for a Trade Test first. Those who qualify the Trade Test will be invited for the Competitive Written Examination as per the above mode.
